Ulster County Office of Employment and Training Ulster County Workforce Development Board Operates Summer Youth Employment Program

The Ulster County Office of Employment and Training (OET) announced that applications for the 2008 Summer Youth Employment Program are now available. This program will provide approximately 100 eligible youth in the County with a summer work experience.

The program is scheduled to begin on July 07 and run for 7 weeks. Youth will be paid \$7.15 per hour for up to 28 hours per week. Jobs will be at public and private not-for- profit agencies throughout Ulster County. To be eligible for the program youth must be Ulster County residents and have family income that is at or below 200% of Federal poverty income standards, and be between the ages of 14 -18 years old.
