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The Community Heart Health Coalition Of Ulster County Announces BodyWorks Summer 2008 At The Kingston Hospital Beginning July 1<sup>st</sup> For 8 Consecutive Weeks

The Ulster County Legislature's Health Services Committee Chairman, Robert Parete – (D-Olive), announces his continued support for *BodyWorks* and urges parents and caregivers of adolescent girls to participate in the program. The first 6 families to sign up and complete the program will receive a \$50.00 gas card. The program will begin July 1 at the Kingston Hospital and there is still room for more participants.

**BodyWorks** received funding through the **H**ealthy **E**ating **A**nd **L**iving/**HEAL** – Ulster County Task Force in 2007 and the Department of Social Services this year. **HEAL**-Ulster was created by Legislator Robert Parete in 2007, which distributed mini-grants to organizations that demonstrate an interest in the development of educational and outreach efforts to combat obesity in our communities.

According to the Healthy Eating And Living (HEAL) Body Mass Index Screening Study, February 2008, of the 2,105 children included in the study, 2% were underweight, 61.85% were of a healthy weight, 16.58% were at risk of becoming overweight, 19.57% were overweight with 4.75% being extremely overweight. In total 36.15% of the children (18.48% males, and 17.67% females), or 1 in 3, are overweight or at risk of overweight. **BodyWorks** is an obesity prevention program to inspire families to grow healthy girls and strong women developed by The Office on Women's Health, U.S Department of Health and Human Services. Parents and caregivers of adolescent girls set action plans to improve family eating and exercise habits. Through facilitated workshops parents and caregivers will learn how to create change for their families and break down the barriers that keep people from engaging in physical activity while recognizing the impact that the environment and media have on their choices.
